COMBINED ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE BENSENVIELE OUNTY Clerk FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #2, COOK AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS
